From IEB perspective: Achievements

- Formalization of the process to take risk science to integrated physical-social/ecological risk application
 - Implementation as (more?) important as results

 - MCA

 - brought diverse skills/people together
 - socially and scientifically acceptable processes
 - Coordination (?) with other similar projects

Moving forward:

- Mechanism should be put in place to give it some form of longevity
 - sharing experiences, products and lessons learned
- Seek support (funding) to provide technical assistance as post project follow up
- Seek efficiencies in approach to risk management
